

SPECIAL MEETING FOR THE TOWN OF CARROLLTON
April 20, 2017

The council for the Town of Carrollton met for a Special Meeting regarding review of Elected Official's Salary, on Thursday, April 20, 2017 at 5:30 p.m., at City Hall, 206 W. Washington, Carrollton, MO 64633.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor, Bryan Mathis.

ROLL CALL

The following Council members were present: Councilman Bartlett, Councilwoman Horine, Mayor Mathis, Councilman Shields and Councilwoman Ward. Councilwoman McCoy was absent.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

A motion was made by Councilman Bartlett and seconded by Councilman Shields to approve the agenda as presented. The motion passed. Council members voting yes were: Bartlett, Horine, Shields and Ward. McCoy was absent.

Review of Elected Official's Salary

Councilwoman Horine recapped the history of the Mayor's salary. In recent years the Mayor's salary had been decreased from \$20,000/year with benefits to \$15,000/year.

Mayor Mathis has increased the efficiency and communication of all the departments. Mathis gets out and works with the crews, any time of the day or night. He has put in many hours helping out wherever help is needed and Mathis does not work part-time.

Discussion was held.

A motion was made by Councilwoman Horine and seconded by Councilwoman Ward that the salary for the Mayor's office be put at \$20,000/year with benefits.

Mayor Mathis stated he would decline the benefits.

An amended motion was made by Councilwoman Horine and seconded by Councilwoman Ward to leave out the benefits but put the Mayor's salary at \$20,000/year. The motion passed without opposition. Council members voting yes were: Bartlett, Horine, Shields and Ward. McCoy was absent.
